<i>Ambrosia artemisifolia</i> - Common ragweed
<i>Ambrosia trifida</i> - Giant ragweed
<i>Cirsium arvense</i> - Canadian thistle
<i>Toxicodendron radicans</i> - Poison ivy
<i>Lythrum salicaria</i> - Purple loosestrife
<i>Allanthurus altissima</i> - Tree of heaven
<i>Ficaria verna</i> - Lesser celandine
<i>Polygonum cuspidatum</i> - Japanese knotweed
<i>Sorghum halepense</i> - Johnsongrass
<i>Lepidium draba sub. draba</i> - Heart-podded horary cress
<i>Vitis spp.</i> - Grapevines (when growing in groups of one hundred or more & not pruned, sprayed, cultivated or otherwise maintained for 2 consecutive years)

<i>Heracleum mantegazzianum</i> - Giant hogweed
<i>Nicandra physalodes</i> - Apple of Peru
<i>Conyza Canadensis</i> - Marehall
<i>Bassia scoparia</i> - Kochia
<i>Amaranthus palmeri</i> - Palmer amaranth
<i>Convolvulus arvensis</i> - Field bindweed
<i>Sonchus arvensis</i> - Perennial sowthistle
<i>Puerari pueraria Montana var. lobata</i> - Kudzu
<i>Pastinaca sativa</i> - Wild parsnip
<i>Lepidium appellanum</i> - Hairy whitetop or Ballcress
<i>Phyllostachys aureasculata</i> - Yellow groove bamboo (when the plant has spread from its original premise of planting & is not being maintained)

<i>Acroptilon repens</i> - Russian knapweed
<i>Euphorbia esula</i> - Leafy spurge
<i>Calystegia sepium</i> - Hedge bindweed
<i>Sorghum x alnum</i> - Columbus grass
<i>Amaranthus tuberculatus</i> - Water hemp
<i>Conium maculatum</i> - Poison hemlock
<i>Senecio glabellus</i> - Cressleaf groundsel
<i>Carduus nutans</i> - Musk thistle
<i>Polygonum perfoliatum</i> - Mile-a-minute weed
<i>Bassia prostrate</i> - Forage kochia
<i>Nassella trichotoma</i> - Serrated tussock
